To obtain the Advanced Reflexology & Life Skills Diploma students will be expected to provide evidence of learning by:

Module 1

- A satisfactory practical reflexology treatment demonstrating and identifying difficult-to-find reflexes and potential health-related problems interpreted to systems of the body unilaterally on the feet (working both feet as systems of the body rather than individually).
- Satisfactory client assessment through 6 hours of case-study material.
- Developing intuitive reflexology
- The significance of the Chakras in health

Module 2

- Personal self-development
- Counselling theory and basic counselling skills
- Raising Awareness
- Psychological client assessment based on basic counselling skills
- Evidence of learning with a 2,000 essay demonstrating:
Client-based experiential understanding and use of counselling skills integrated into reflexology practice from case-study material in Module 1 and evidence of self-reflective personal development.

Completion of the Diploma is by assessment, as outlined above. Students are expected to attend Course dates, or arrange individual tuition with the Principal.

DIFFICULTY MEETING THE FEES?

An alternative method of meeting Course fees is to apply for a Career Development Loan (CDL), which are run by the Learning & Skills Council, in partnership with three leading High Street Banks. Funding is provided to support vocational and educational training. The LSC pays the interest on your loan whilst learning and up to one month post-qualification. You then repay the loan to the bank over an agreed period of time at a fixed rate of interest. You must know what programme of study you will be following before you apply for a CDL.
